CAMP SCHEDULE:

Classes will meet each weekday from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM. Student's daily schedule will include:

Music Theory/History: Teachers will use ear training and note reading to enhance the student's musical understanding and interpretation, while building a solid base of musical terms and symbols.

New Tunes: Learn and read new pieces from diverse repertoire including fiddle and classical selections. Through scaffolded instruction, these pieces will be combined in large and whole group classes.

Small Group: Groups of 5-10 students assigned according to current level. Students collaborate with peers and work on solo music.

Large Ensemble: Two small groups combine to receive focused instruction on playing 2 and 3- part harmony.

Percussion Group: Scheduled daily

Whole Group: All students will meet for class at the end of the day to share the day's learning experiences.

Enrichment: Daily, this will include activities such as dance, drama, singing, crafts, outings, videos, or special guests, and a final concert each Friday at 2:30 PM. Parents and guests are invited and encouraged to attend this special performance.

Private Lesson: A weekly 30 minute lesson Private Lesson: will be scheduled with the assigned teacher. Teachers will review solos and music introduced at camp.
